

5.19 – GED Enrollment -- Crawford County Continuing Education Center

The Crawford County Continuing Education Center provides access to General Equivalency Diploma (GED) programs under the following conditions.

1. All students regularly admitted to GED programs must be at least 18 years of age at the time of initial enrollment.
2. Students who are current active students of the Van Buren School District may not be admitted to the GED program.
3. Under extraordinary circumstances, students age 16 and 17 may be admitted to the GED program if all of the following conditions exist:
 - a. The student must be so significantly behind in his/her high school course of study that it will be impossible to graduate on time even if the student fully accesses the resources of both The Basic School and the Van Buren School District Career Center.
 - b. The student must be recommended for admission to a GED program by a committee consisting of the VBHS principal, VBHS counselor, and the Career Center Director after a full and complete review of the student's education program.
