Analysis of Assessment Data:

The River Valley Virtual Academy has analyzed data from multiple sources. Data sources include assessment data from ACT Aspire, ACT, iStation, Arkansas School Report Card, Arkansas Standards for Accreditation, Pearson Connexus Online and Blended Learning, Flex Point, ESSA, grades, and Eschool demographic information. The data demonstrate a need to improve ACT Aspire and iStation scores.

The River Valley Virtual Academy began implementing weekly onsite one-on-one reading tutoring each week. In addition, Ignite Reading tutors will be purchased for the upcoming school year. Tutors will primarily focus on K-5

Science of Reading Skills with students scoring the lowest in reading in the Fall of 2023. Reading tutors will work with students 5 days per week online based on Dibels assessment data.

Ongoing professional development in the area of Response to Intervention and Professional Learning Communities will continue for the upcoming school year.

Materials and supplies will be purchased to support students.

Goals:

- 1. The River Valley Virtual Academy students will be ready or exceeding on the ACT Aspire mathematics summative assessment.**
- 2. The River Valley Virtual Academy students will be ready or exceeding on the ACT Aspire reading summative assessment.**

Actions:

- 1. Provide additional support for students through the use of iStation and supplemental support sessions.**
- 2. Evaluate student progress weekly.**
- 3. Provide professional development to staff members in the Learning Management System to ensure appropriate monitoring of student achievement and support.**

Monitoring and Evaluation:

To monitor the implementation of the plan, The River Valley Virtual Academy will record school-level data to ensure students are on-track to complete courses successfully. The River Valley Virtual Academy will also monitor communication between RVVA staff members and students to ensure an ongoing conversation with families.

Literacy Plan:

Reading Achievement: Students reading below grade level in grades K-8 were provided additional support through Core5 Lexia. A variety of supplemental instructional support programs have been made available to support student learning in the areas of phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, comprehension, fluency, and writing.

The River Valley Virtual Academy is currently working towards implementing Ignite Reading for the Fall of 2023 for all students in grades K-8 to provide Tier 3 instructional support. Ignite will provide one-on-one tutors based on Dibels assessment data and the Science of Reading. In addition, RVVA will continue to support Tier 2 instruction through Lexia Core5. The RVVA will purchase additional technology as needed to support student needs, provide professional development to staff members, and purchase materials and supplies to assist families.
