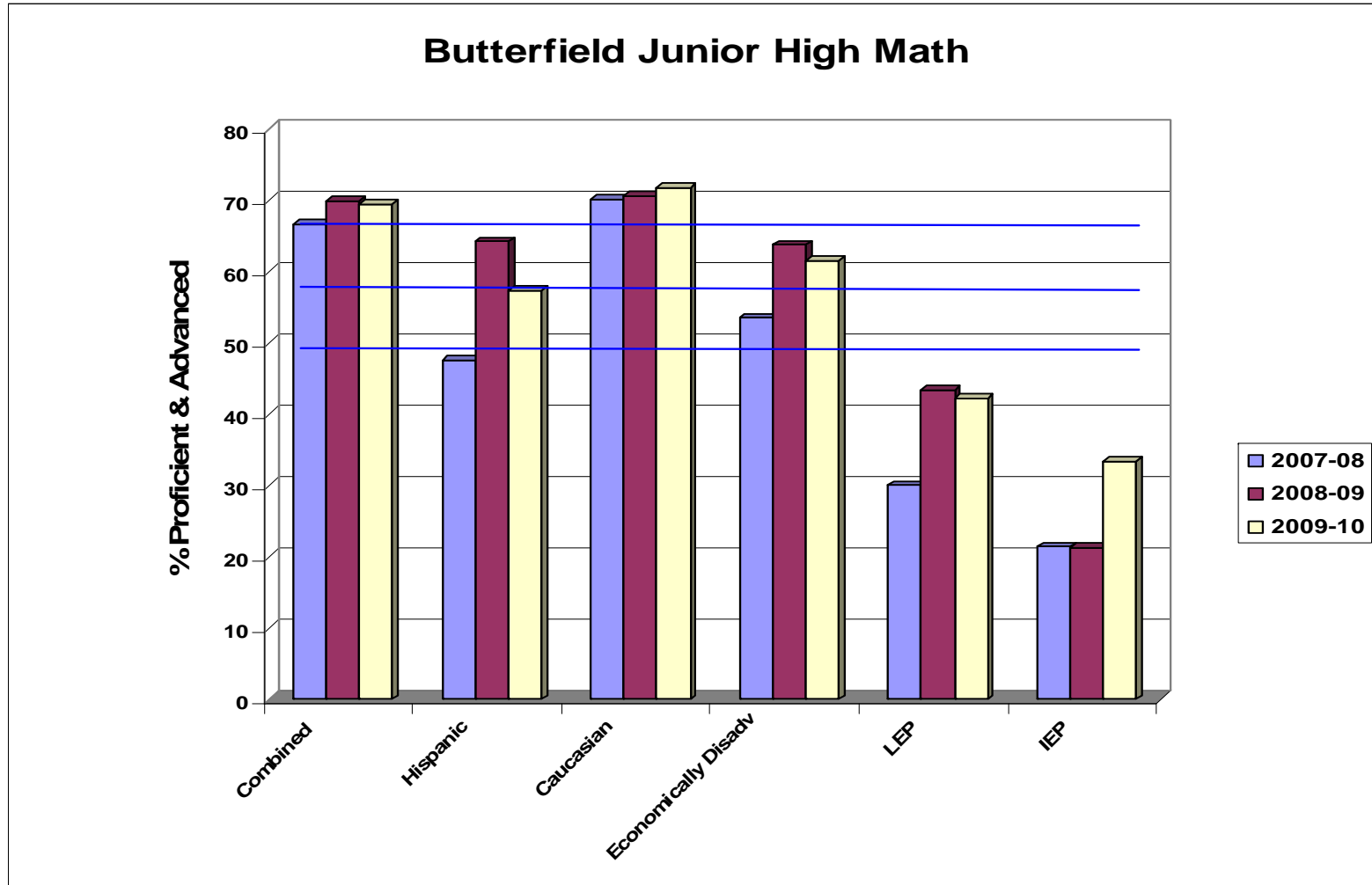
Van Buren High School Math



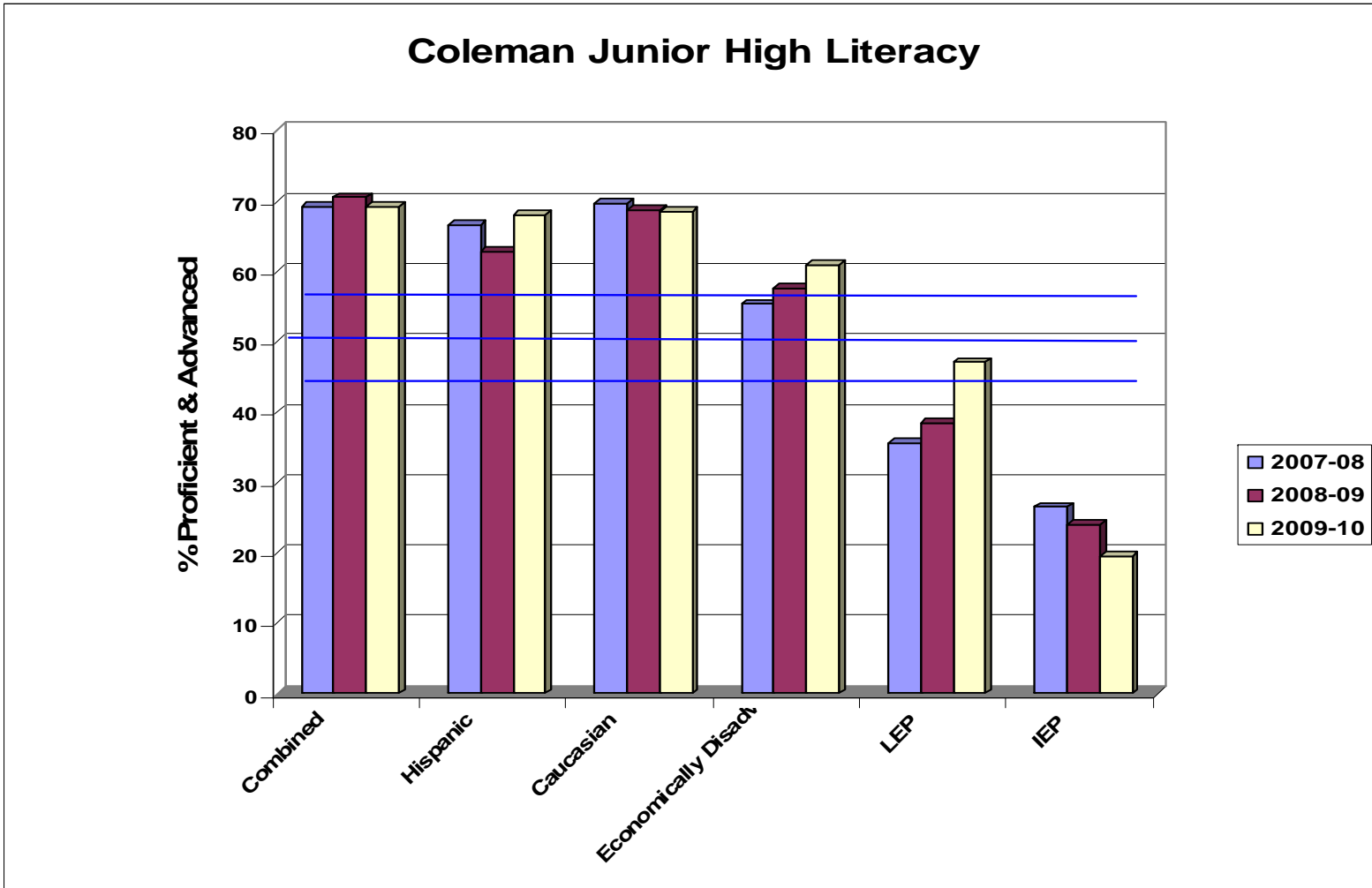
Butterfield Junior High Literacy



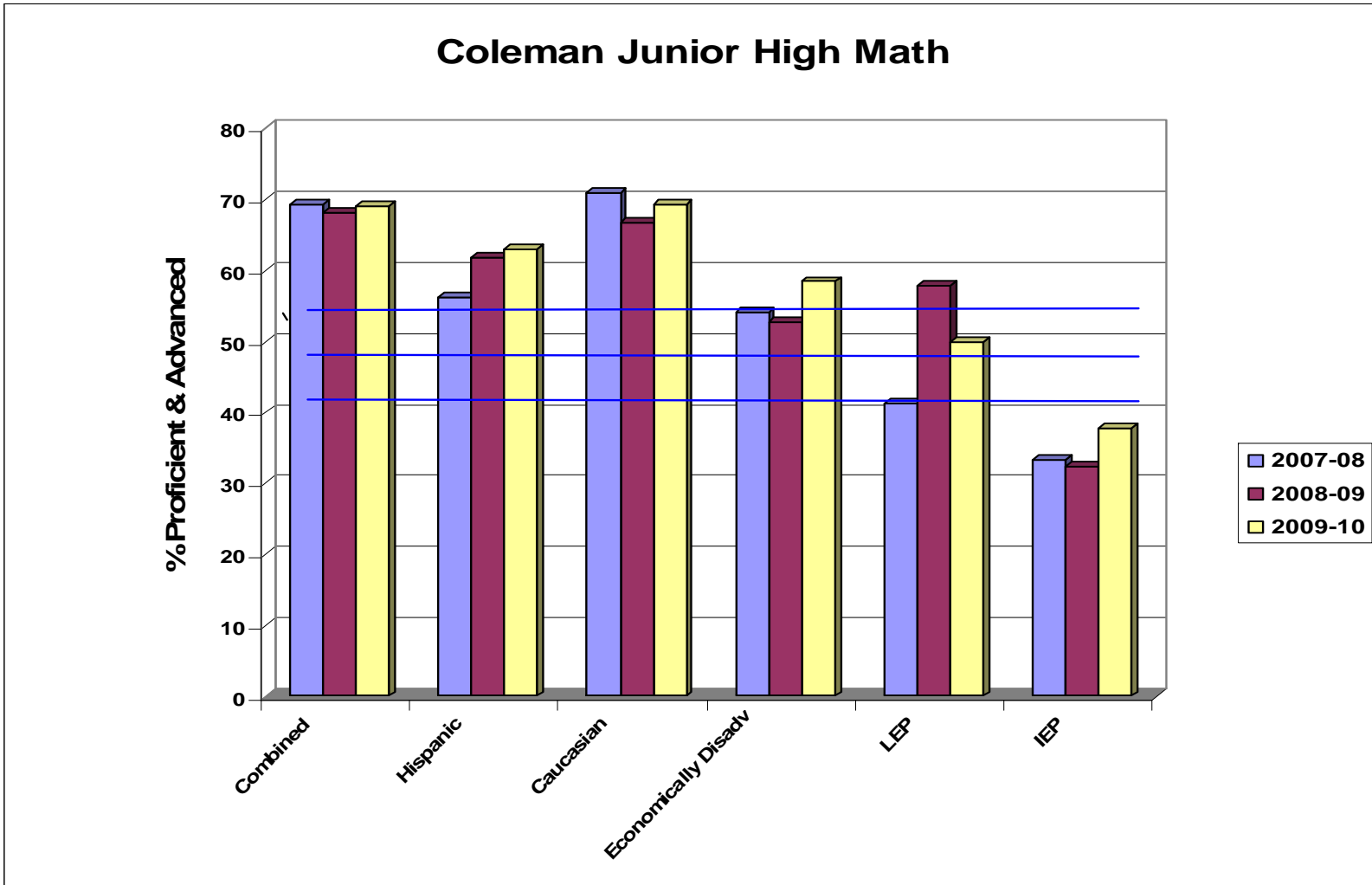

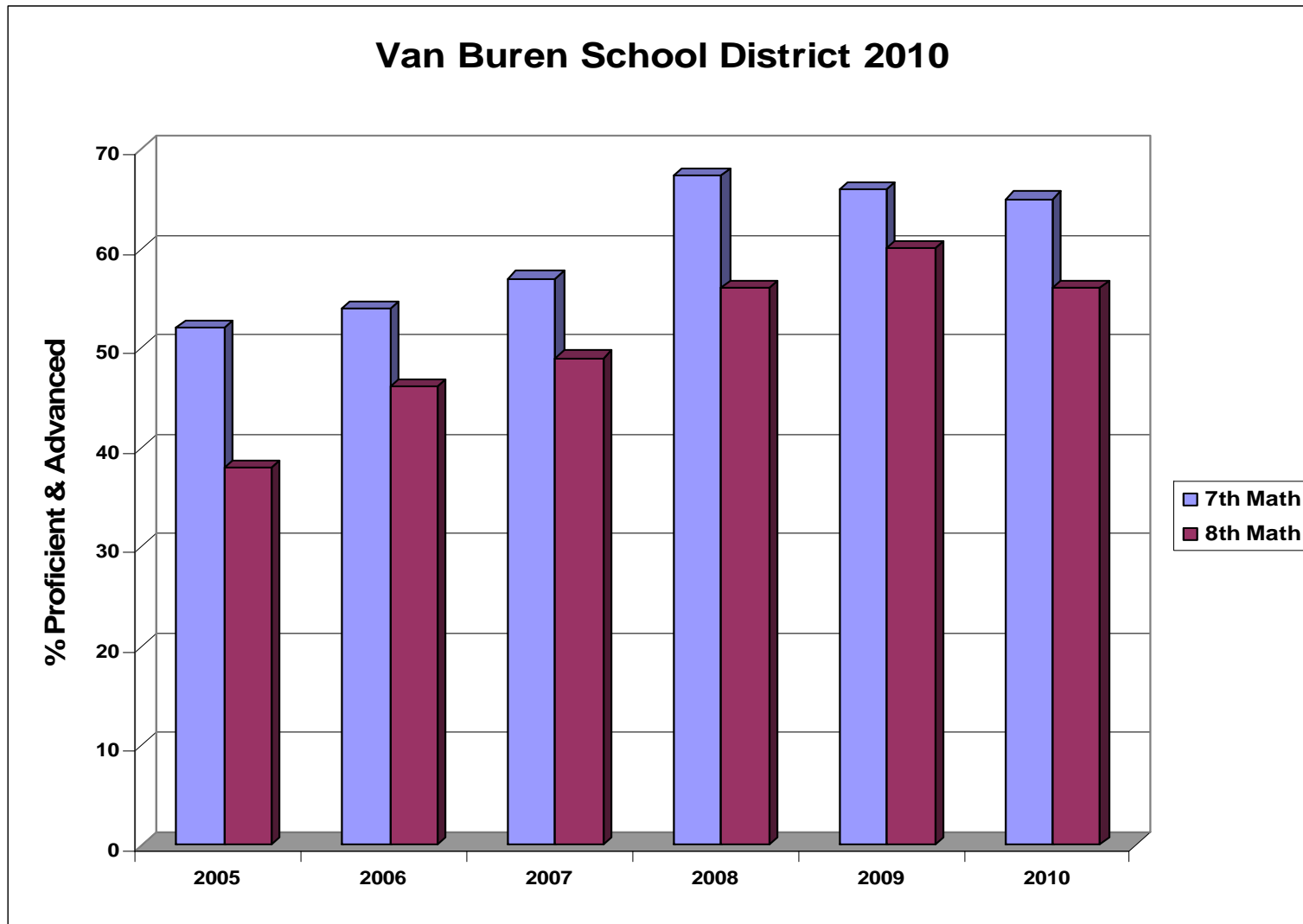

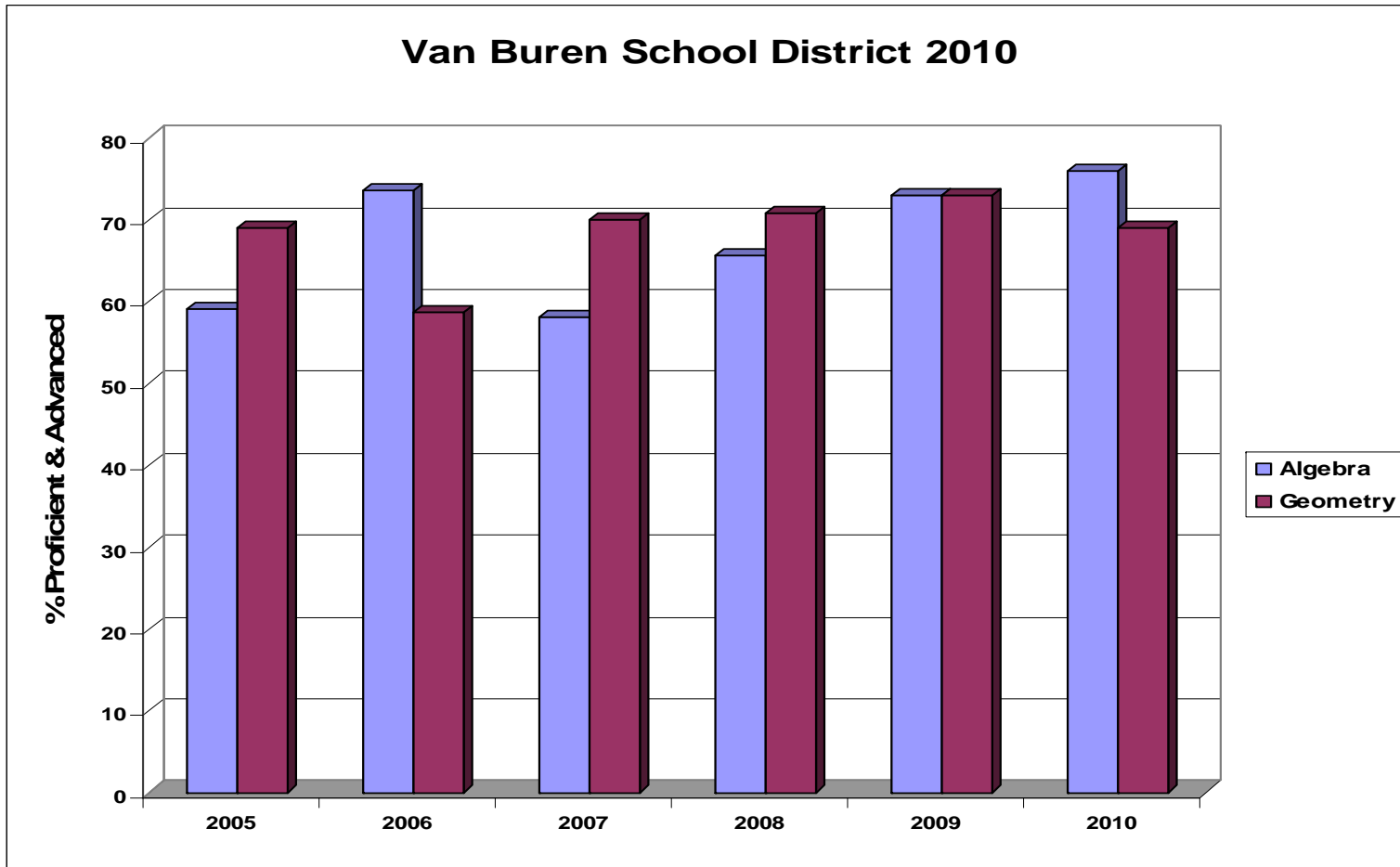

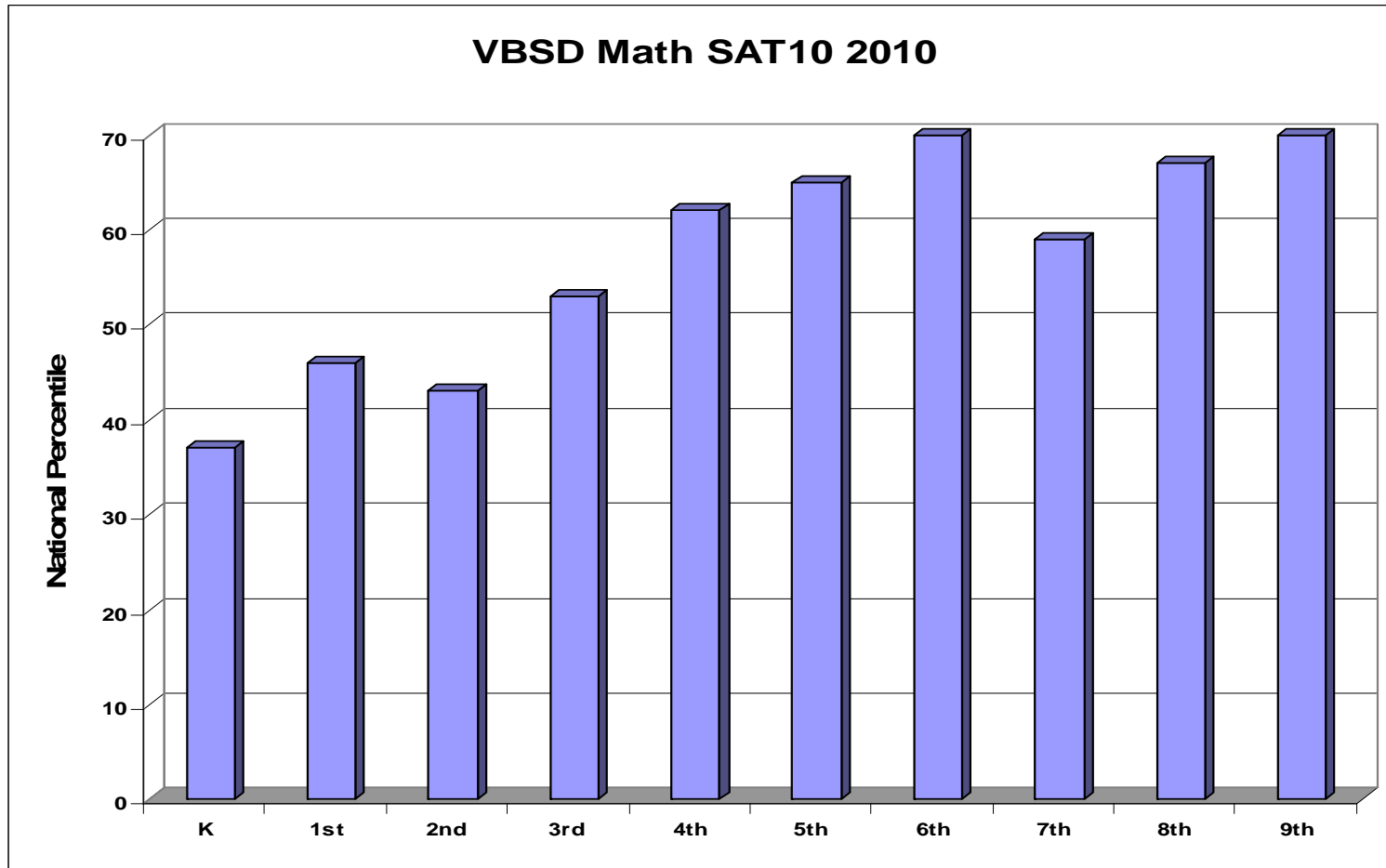
7th & 8th Grade Math Benchmark Scores



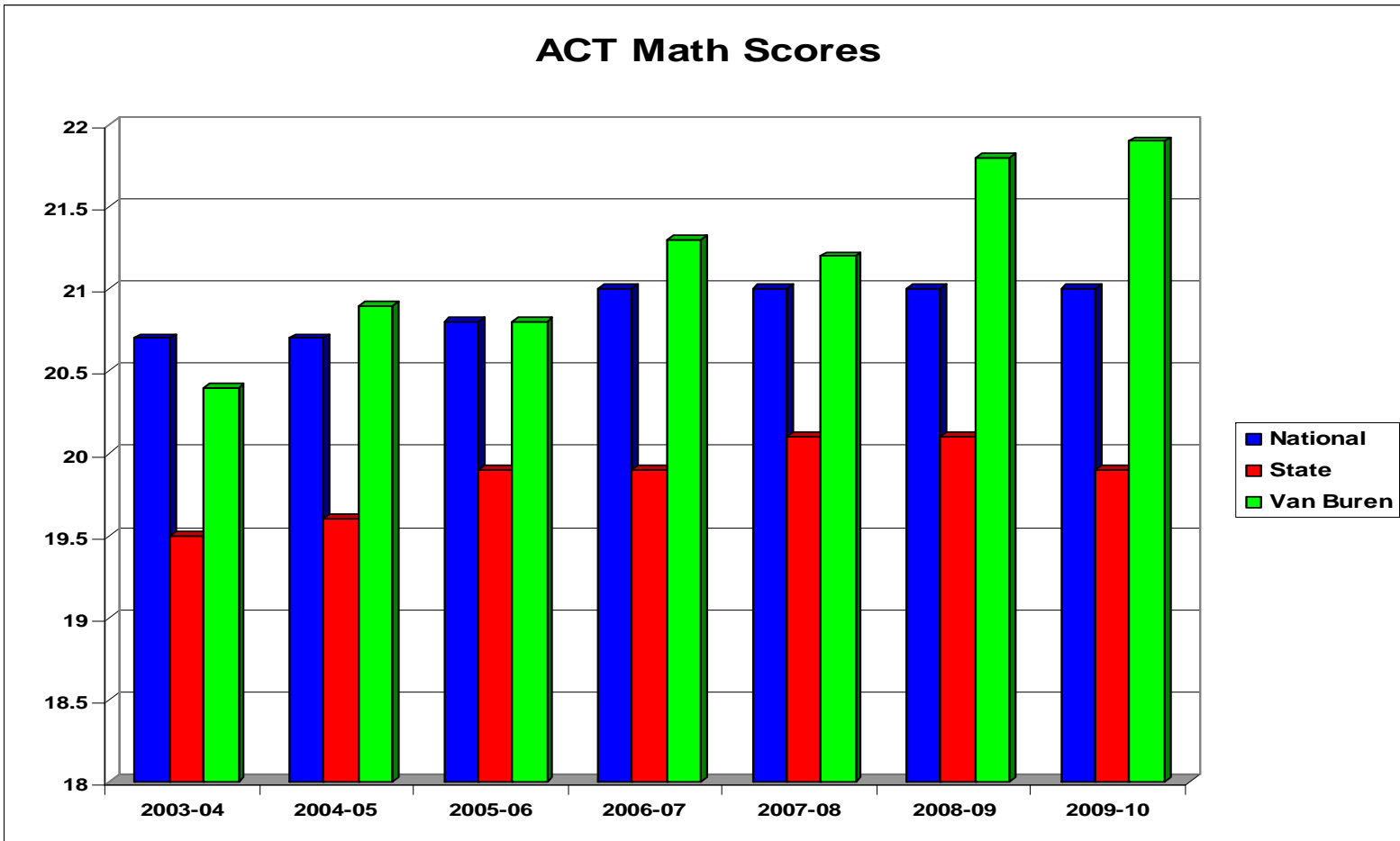
Algebra & Geometry EOC Scores



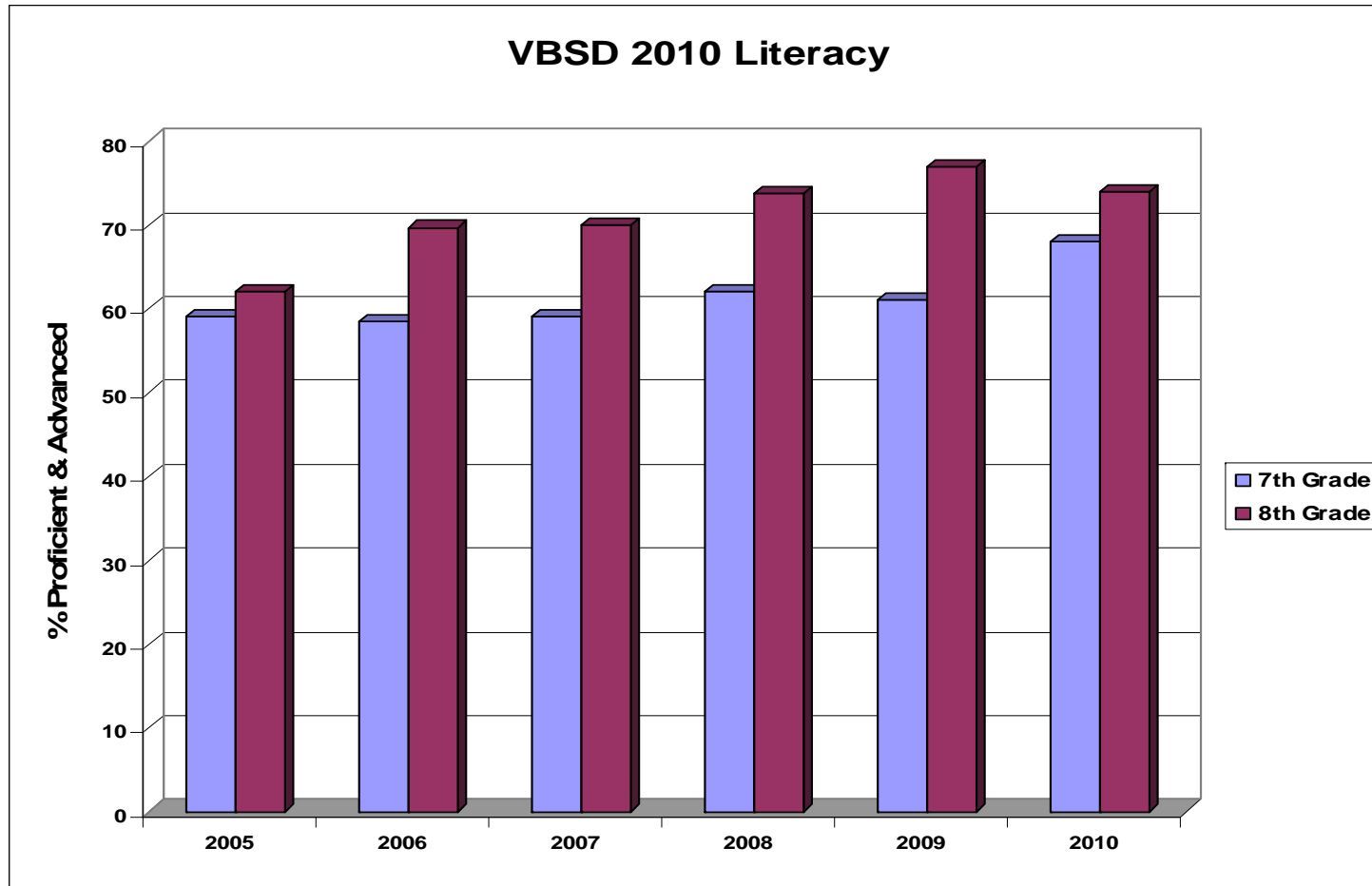
VBSD Math SAT10 Scores



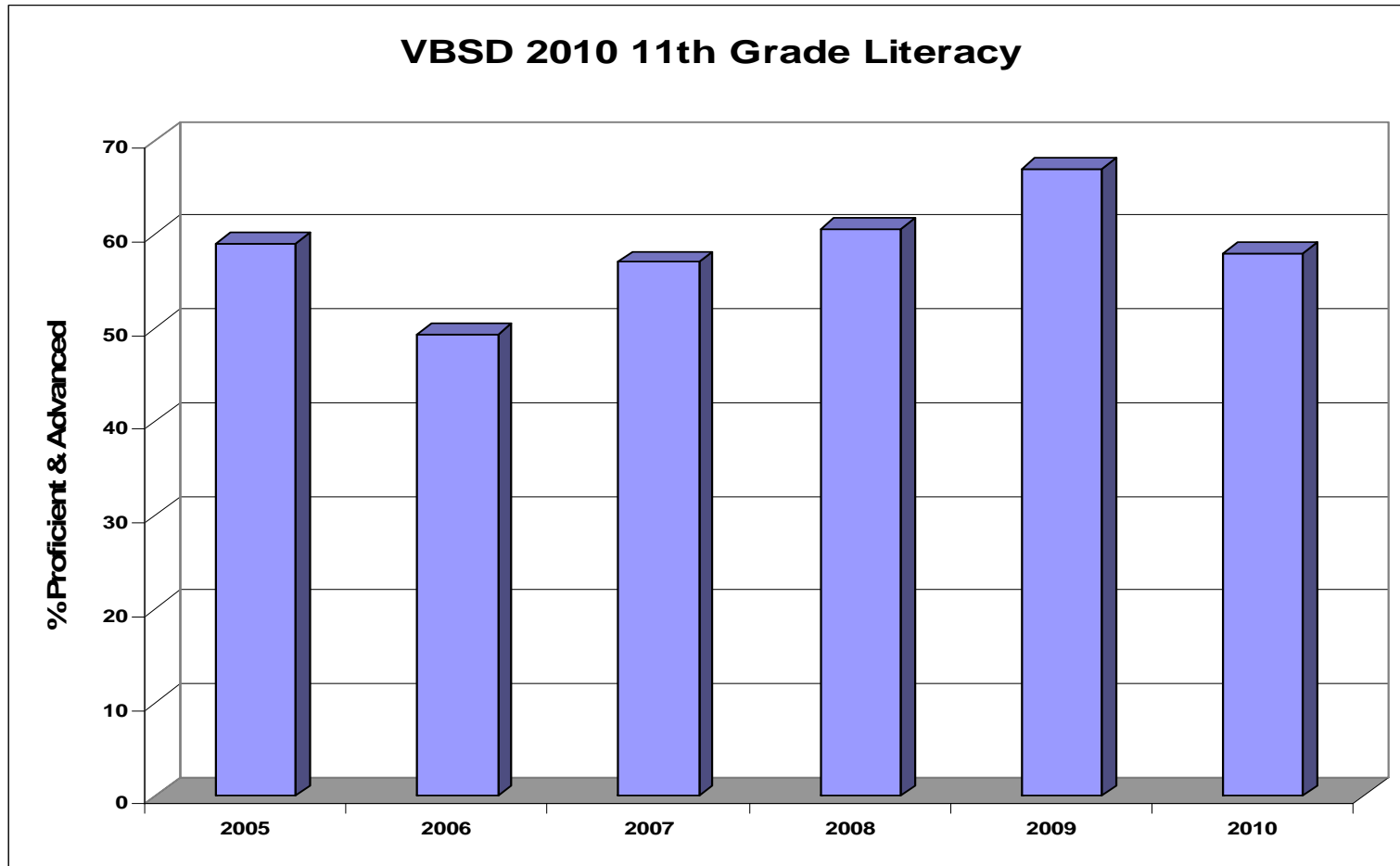
ACT Math Scores 2004-10



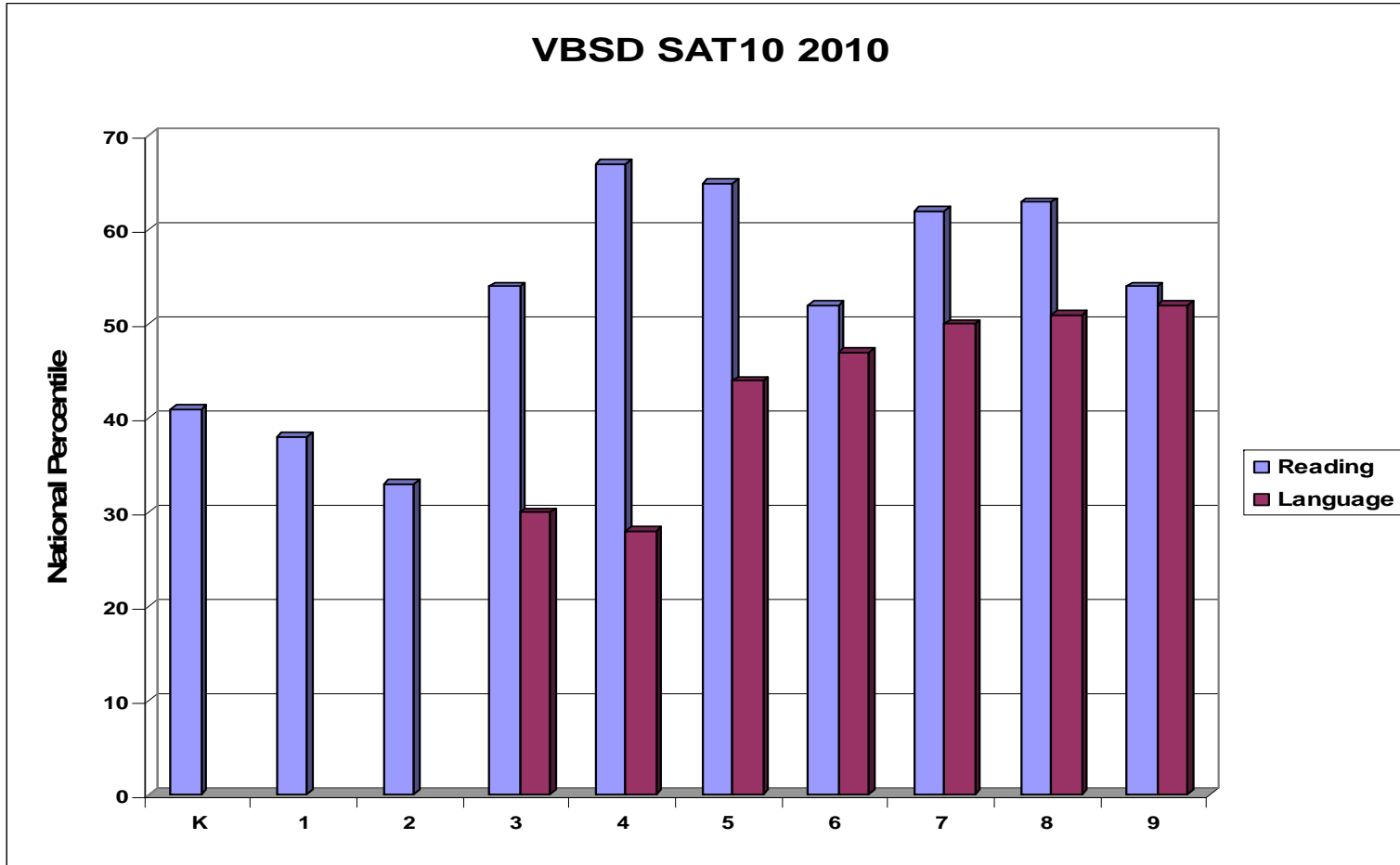

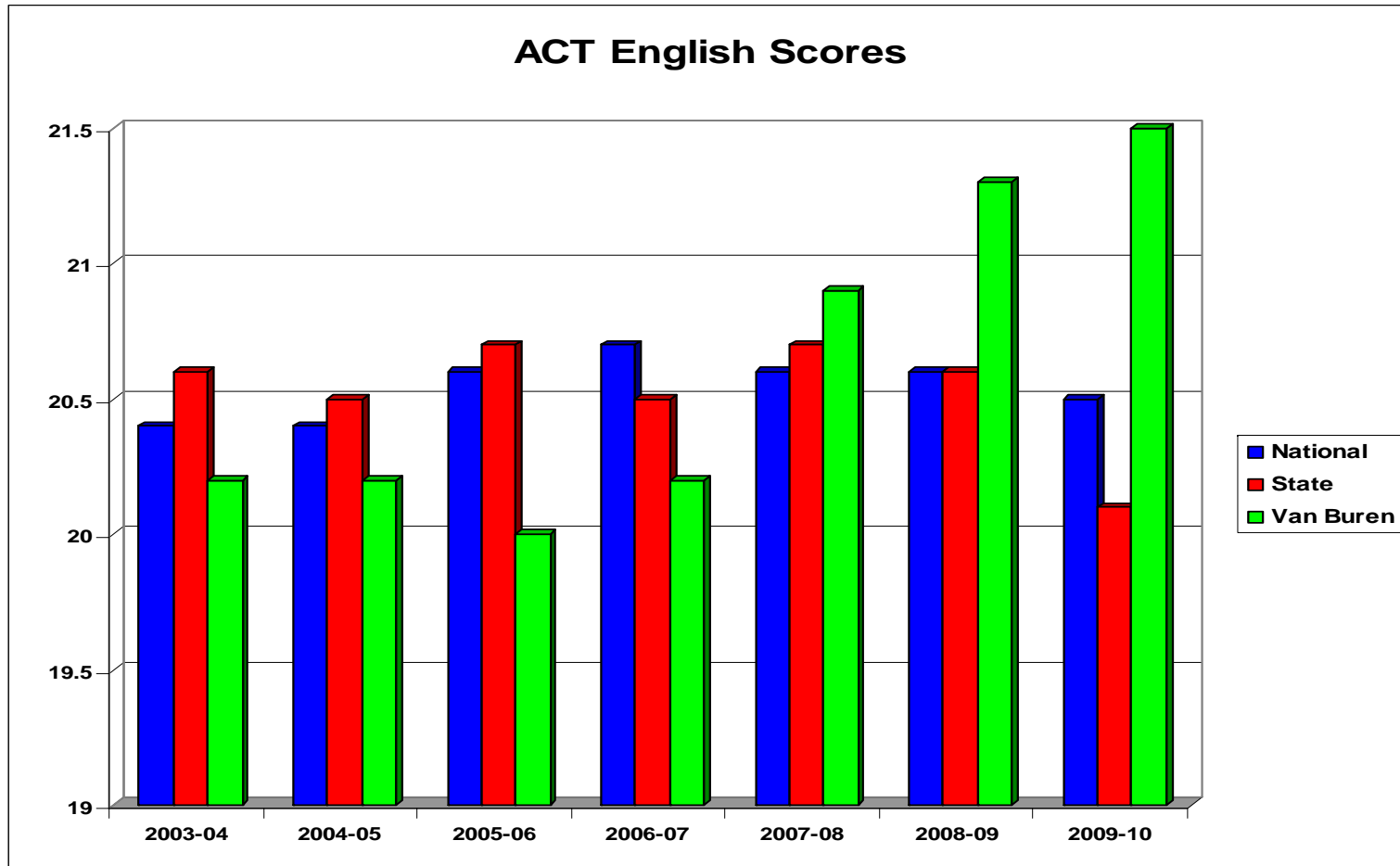

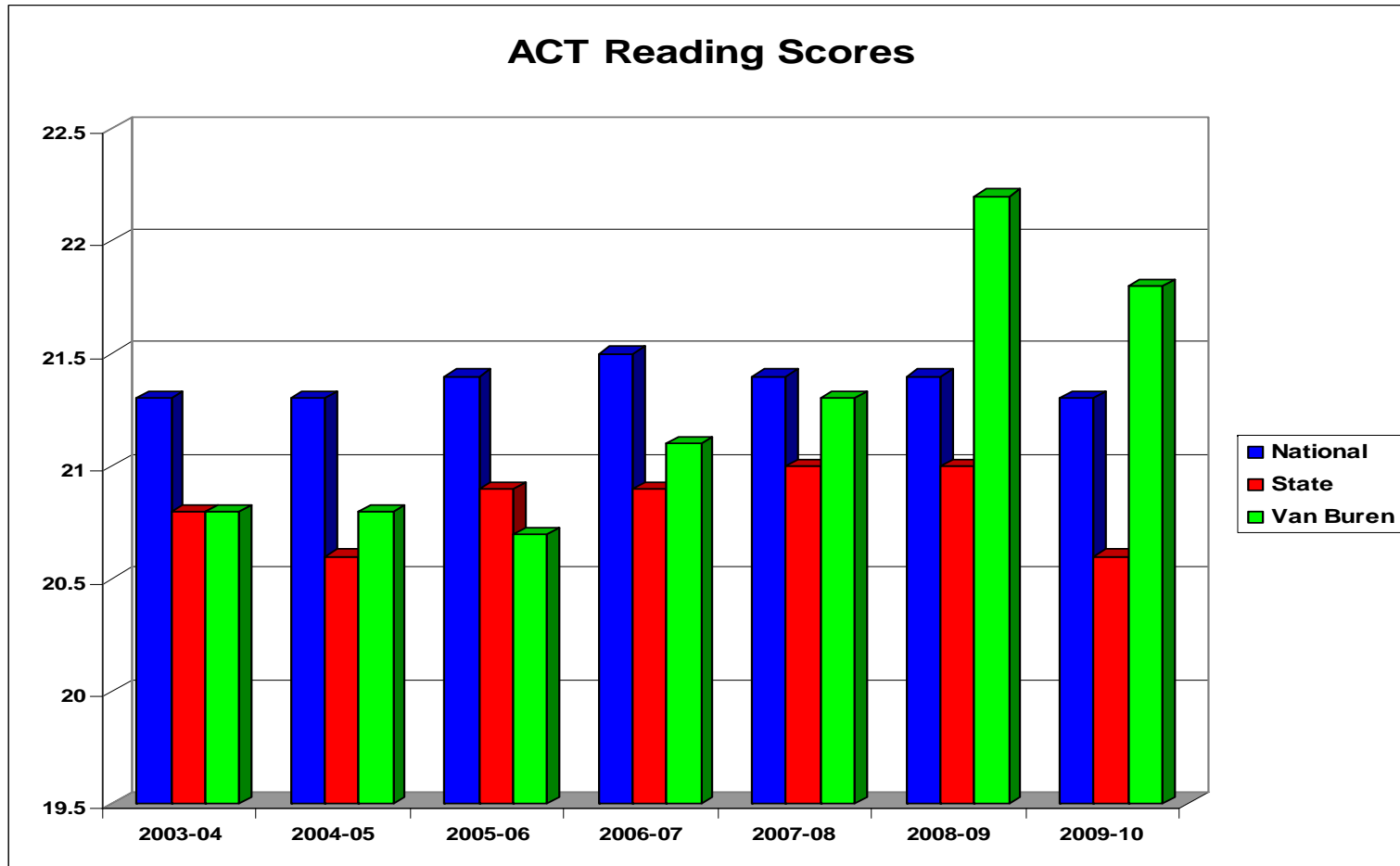

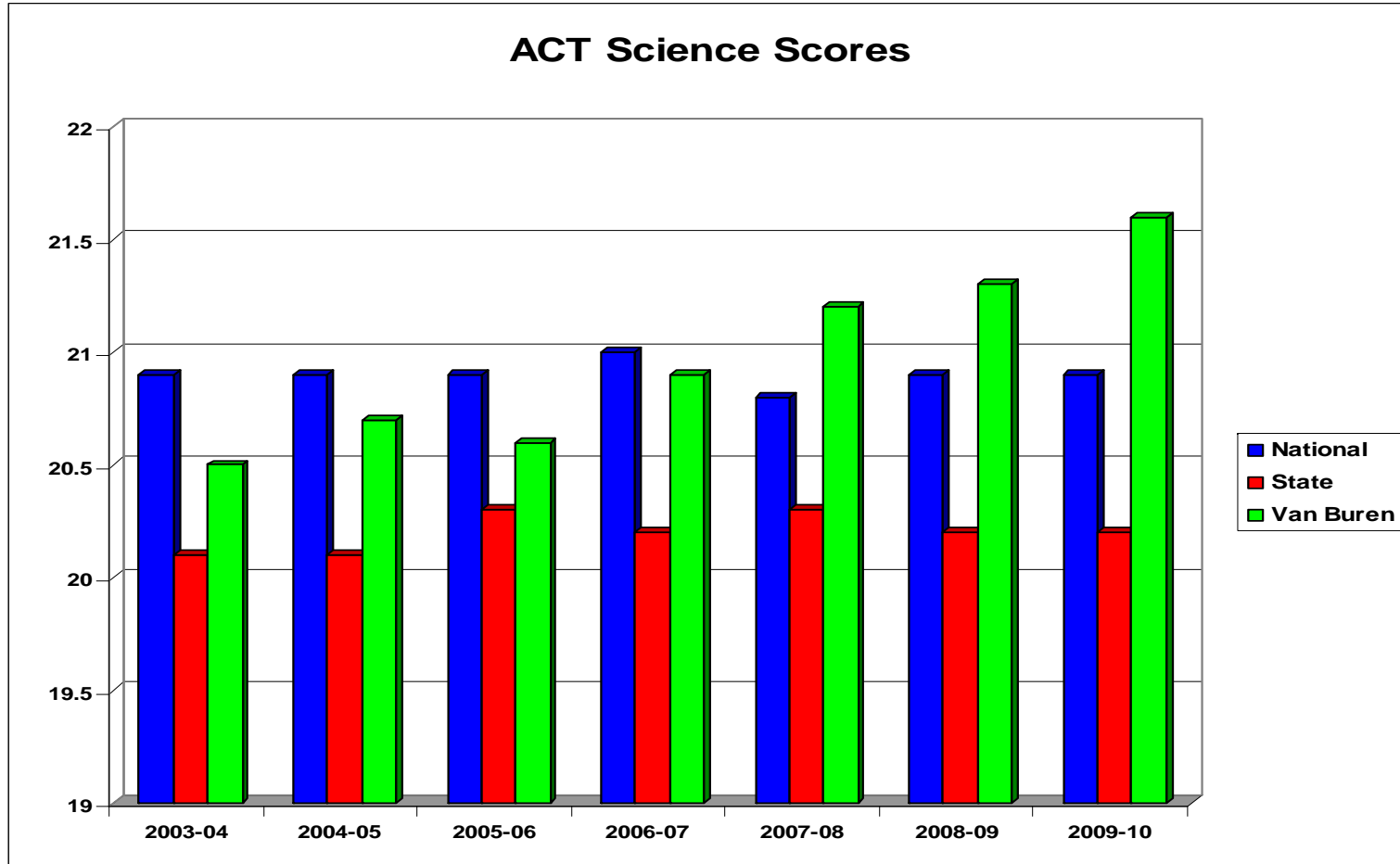
