If you would like to request accommodations based on an IEP, 504 or ELL (English Language Learner) documentation for your child, you must sign the Consent for Release of Information to ACT and return it to Ms. Parkerson by November 6, 2018. Please be aware that additional information may be required such as a Letter of Professional Diagnosis (from doctor, therapist, etc.) if requesting accommodations based on an IEP or 504.
- Individual photo retake day will be Thursday, Nov. 7. Drapes and shirts/jackets will be provided for seniors. Sophomores and Juniors should dress appropriately.
