- Reminder about ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES:


• A written note or an email must be given to one of the secretaries in the office within 5 school days for an absence to be excused by parent permission (no doctor's note). <u>christie.murders@vbsd.us</u> • Any student who misses over 10 minutes of any class will be counted absent for that class. • Students who accumulate more than 10 unexcused absences in an individual class during the semester may be denied course credit. Students will be allowed 6 excused absences (without doctor's note); any absences after the 6 excused absence days will be counted as unexcused.
