Drew Cone reported for the district-

- BAM classes are being offered at Central Elementary at 5:15am, 4pm and 4:30pm Monday-Friday for free to VBSD employees

- Reviewed partnerships in the community and JUA grant awards. JUA grants have awarded a total of \$526,000.00 in the last 7 years to VBSD. This has helped to build walking trails and improve facilities
