Van Buren School District Health Services Kindergarten Registration

Dear Parents:

Kindergarten Registration will be held on *Friday, April 12, 2024*, at the elementary school zone in which you reside. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m.

The following requirements have been set forth for all enrolling kindergarten students by the Van Buren School District and by the Arkansas Department of Education.

Students must be 5 years old on or before August 1st to be eligible for the **2024 - 2025** school year. Each student must furnish documentation of a comprehensive physical examination. These physicals are available at various local physician and pediatrician offices. The examination must have been done within the last 2 years to be acceptable.

Please remember your enrollment is not complete until all of the following items have been furnished to the school office:

1. **Up-to-date Immunization Record**:

- 4 DTaP and 3 Polio doses, one of which was received after the 4th birthday
- 3 Hepatitis B vaccines,
- 2 MMR's one of which were received after the 1st birthday, and
- 2 Varicella (chicken Pox vaccine) vaccines one of which were received after the 1st

birthday, **1 Dose of Hepatitis A**, on or after 1st birthday.

- 2. <u>Social Security Card.</u> An application for a social security card may be obtained for the Social Security Division at 4977 Old Greenwood Road, Fort Smith.
- 3. Birth Certificate. Legal document or hospital certificate citing your child's birth.
- 4. <u>Comprehensive Physical Exam.</u> Forms for physicals may be picked up in the school office and at most physician's offices in the area.

The Vaccination For Children clinics in our area include:

- *The Crawford County Health Clinic which is located at 2040 Chestnut (behind Baptist Health). You may schedule an appointment for immunizations by calling 474-6391.
- *The Hamby Medical Clinic is located at 30 Northridge Drive, 922-9355. Hours are 8:30am-11am and 1:30pm-3pm. Please bring a copy of your current immunization record.
