

#### **4.3.1 -- STUDENT DISCIPLINE -- GENERAL STATEMENT OF JURISDICTION**

**Important Note:** The following policy was developed to protect a school district's ability to discipline students for off-campus acts and misbehavior not specifically addressed by a district's student handbook. (A school district's authority in these areas was severely limited by Act 742 of 1997).

##### **Student Discipline**

A student may be suspended, expelled or otherwise disciplined for immorality, refractory conduct, insubordination, infectious disease, habitual uncleanliness, other infractions of the Student Conduct Behavior Code , or other conduct that would tend to impair the discipline of the school or harm the other pupils, regardless of whether the student's conduct occurs on or off campus and during or between school terms and regardless of whether a specific prohibition of the conduct is contained in the student handbook.
