

4.3.7 -- AUTHORITY FOR STUDENT DISCIPLINE

Teachers, principals, administrators and service personnel, such as bus drivers, have the authority to take customary and reasonable measures to maintain proper control and discipline among students placed under their care and supervision. Such measures may include the use of reasonable force in the exercise of lawful authority to restrain or correct pupils and maintain order.

The use of reasonable force, such as corporal punishment, shall be limited by the provisions of other policies, including JCDA and JDA. Only building principals or other building or district office administrators may use corporal punishment, except as provided in Policy JDA.

Bus Drivers will be advised of their responsibility for discipline on the bus and their limitations in maintaining control and discipline at the workshop at the beginning of each year, and in written form.
