

5.8 -- SCHEDULES

Each principal shall furnish the office of the Superintendent of Schools a copy of the program of each teacher in the school.

The elementary school teacher in developing a daily program should consider the following factors:

1. Sufficient time shall be provided in the program to instruct the students adequately in the courses listed by the State Department of Education.
2. A minimum of six (6) hours of instructional time shall be provided in the daily schedule.
3. The schedule shall be sufficiently flexible to provide for adequate ability level grouping within the classroom.
4. There are days when the daily program must be changed by the classroom teacher for special events or activities.
5. The local Board of Education suggests the schedule recommended by the State Department of Education be followed in all elementary schools.
